HOW DOES THE MENTAL HEALTH LEVY HELP THE COMMUNITY?

- ⇒ The current mental health and recovery services levy in Richland County was passed in 1986 and renewed most recently in 2016.
- ⇒ We are placing a 1 mil, 10-year levy RENEWAL on the ballot for the November 4th election. **This is NOT a new tax or a tax increase.**
- ⇒ Over the past five years, the Board has received an average of \$2,218,256.42 in annual funding generated by the levy.

2024 BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES OVERVIEW:

In 2024 the Richland County Mental Health and Recovery Services Board in collaboration with our partners served **10,714** unique individuals with **3,520** of them being youth (0-17) and **7,194** being adults (18+). Additionally, **16,899** individuals participated in prevention programs. The system jointly provided a variety of services to individuals including:

- ◇ **7,257** received Mental Health Treatment
- ◇ **2,453** received Substance Use Disorder Treatment
- ◇ **1,224** accessed Medication-Assisted Treatment
- ◇ **1,144** utilized Harm Reduction programming
- ◇ **890** accessed Recovery Supports programming
- ◇ **29** pregnant women with substance use disorder were served
- ◇ **239** parents with substance use disorder and dependent children served
- ◇ **7,862** calls to the Helpline
