You can access this FREE service 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, by texting "4hope" to #741-741.

September 1st to 30th: Mobile Response and Stabilization Services (MRSS) is a free, community based program for Richland County residents under age 21 who are experiencing a mental health or behavioral health crisis. MRSS provides rapid, in person support by sending trained crisis responders to the crisis location to help deescalate the situation, develop a safety plan, and connect families to ongoing support and services.
